“What is it that makes this miracle happen? I want to suggest to you that the power of a constitution rests ultimately on the commitment of the people to that document as an embodiment of their hopes and dreams. If they believe in it, and only if they believe in it, so deeply that a violation of the constitution feels like a violation of themselves, can the constitution have the power to do what a constitution is supposed to do.”

“We struggle over these words because it is only our belief in them that gives them the power to protect us. So, when you find yourselves engaged in that struggle as lawyers, remember that what you do matters. It matters tremendously, because you are the guardians and interpreters of these ideals.”
